Our Organization, PUCHOG, was founded to give Wounded Warriors a gift, the gift of Hockey. We are using hockey as a means of therapy; physical, mental and emotional.

Hockey uses many of the skills we learned in the military. You have to be tough, quick thinking, calm under pressure and have a sense of team. The PUCHOG Hockey Program invites Wounded Warriors of all abilities to play hockey and keeps them engaged as a unit.

There is never a cost to the Warrior for equipment or ice time and, as you can probably imagine, the costs are high. It costs us about \$1,000 per player to equip, and about \$1,000 per player per year for ice time. PUCHOG is holding two events in the near future to help raise money to defray our costs. We invite you to be a part of these events.

Our fourth annual hockey tournament, Hockey for Heroes, will be held this year on May 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> at Twin Ponds East. The participating teams are established, adult league hockey teams, not necessarily veterans. Tattered Flag Brewery sponsored two teams last year comprised of all veterans. The proceeds from the tournament, including an auction and raffle, all benefit the PUCHOG Hockey Program.

This year, we are also holding the inaugural Pinchot Park Poker Paddle on August 5. This will be a kayaking event where participants pick up a playing card at each of the five launches and at the end the participant with the best poker hand wins a prize.
